### **To have a wall considered for a mural please consider the following criteria:**

The following criteria will be used by Mural Corps Youth to select mural projects:

1. Commitment of mural sponsors to organizing at least two (2) community meetings with Mural Corps and a group of community stakeholders. "Community" for an indoor mural is defined by those who experience the wall (ie staff, clients, students...)
2. Willingness to include youth in community and Mural Corps youth in the mural process.
3. Suitability of wall
4. Significance of project for youth and community.
5. Willingness to organize a dedication acknowledging the mural and youth artists at completion (this can be very simple gathering).
6. A committed contact person to coordinate with instructor and youth.
