

## Mural Arts Philadelphia Celebrates the Voices, Stories, and Murals in Our Community at Wall Ball 2023 Gala Fundraiser on April 27, 2023

Honoring artists, community, and the Community Murals program at Mural Arts

**Philadelphia**, **PA** – **April 11**, **2023** – <u>Mural Arts Philadelphia</u> announces **Wall Ball 2023**, an annual gala fundraiser celebrating public art and the power of community, to be held on Thursday, April 27, 2023, at the 2300 Arena in South Philadelphia. Presented by <u>Citizens</u>, this year's event will recognize Mural Arts' Community Murals department. This unique initiative empowers individuals by giving voice to every person in every part of the city, lifting untold stories, and highlighting local heroes and history. This year, Mural Arts is bringing a *Def Poetry Jam Reunion* for Wall Ball 2023 to celebrate the incredible work of Sonia Sanchez, Philadelphia's first poet laureate. Sonia, along with artist Danny Simmons are Mural Arts' 2023 Visionary Artist Awardees. The event will also honor Leslie Richards, CEO & General Manager of SEPTA, for her tireless advocacy and partnership with Mural Arts, which has transformed transit stations and provided same-day wages to hundreds of unhoused Philadelphians through its *Color Me Back* program.

Seven acclaimed poets - Bonafide Rojas, Khemist Mayfield, Ursula Rucker, Derick Cross, Vanessa Hidrary, Kraal 'Kayo' Charles, and Lamar Mason - will be in attendance, most of whom will perform in the style of the iconic *Def Poetry Jam* television series. Lezlie Harrison, vocalist, bandleader, and on-air



radio host at the preeminent jazz radio station, WBGO, will be the MC and will perform during the evening. The event is expected to bring together Mural Arts supporters, artists, local government officials, and community and business leaders for a night of celebration and fundraising towards Mural Arts' mission of transforming public spaces and individual lives through art.

"Through our Community Murals department, we collaborate with community members to imagine and lead projects that build social capital, develop a sense of communal ownership over space, represent diversity, and empower people to make change in their city," said **Jane Golden, Executive Director of Mural Arts Philadelphia**. "These community murals not only highlight important figures and themes from Philadelphia's history but also bring together neighbors and new friends, reminding us of who we are and where we are going."

## • Danny Simmons, Artist

<u>Danny Simmons</u> is a published author, poet, painter, and philanthropist. He is a leader in the art world with his philanthropic ventures, artistic talents, and creative mind and drive. Danny Simmons played an instrumental role in the conceiving of and co-producing the hit HBO show Def Poetry Jam and won a Tony Award for the Broadway version of the show. Today, his works appear in the Brooklyn Academy of Music, The Smithsonian, the United Nations, the United States State Department Collection, the PAFA Collection, the Brooklyn Museum, and more. He continues to thrive at his 'home gallery' in Philadelphia, PA.

• Sonia Sanchez, Poet, Activist & Writer



<u>Sonia Sanchez</u> is the author of more than 20 books and a recipient of the 2022 Ruth Lilly Poetry Prize. *Does Your House Have Lions*? was a National Book Critics Circle Award finalist. Sanchez is the Poetry Society of America's 2001 Robert Frost Medalist and a Ford Freedom Scholar from the Charles H. Wright Museum of African American History. In December 2011, Philadelphia Mayor Michael Nutter selected Sonia Sanchez as Philadelphia's first poet laureate, calling her "the longtime conscience of the city." Sanchez has lectured at more than 500 universities and colleges in the United States and has traveled extensively to read her poetry. Sanchez lives in Philadelphia.

## • Leslie Richards, CEO & General Manager of SEPTA

<u>Leslie S. Richards</u> is the CEO and 11th General Manager of the Southeastern Pennsylvania Transportation Authority (SEPTA), the sixth largest public transportation agency in the U.S. that enables the five million residents of the Greater Philadelphia region to connect to each other. A staunch advocate for women and diversity in transportation and government, Richards has been recognized for her leadership in the industry and commitment to public service. She lives with her husband in Philadelphia.
