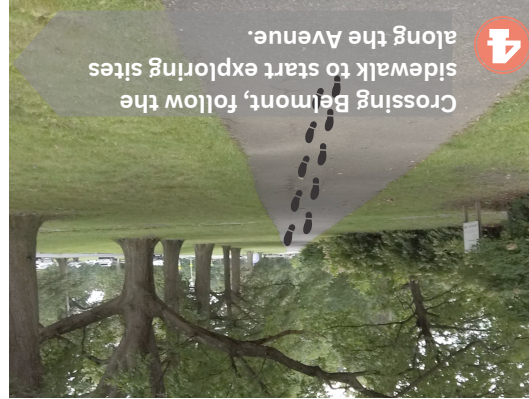




8 Kelly Pool: A free public pool with shaded grounds

The #38 travels along Market street in Center City, through West to the Parkside neighborhood or West Fairmount Park. To start exploring, hop off at Belmont and Ave of the Republic to explore the path around Concourse Lake. In the distance you'll see the Mann Music Center.

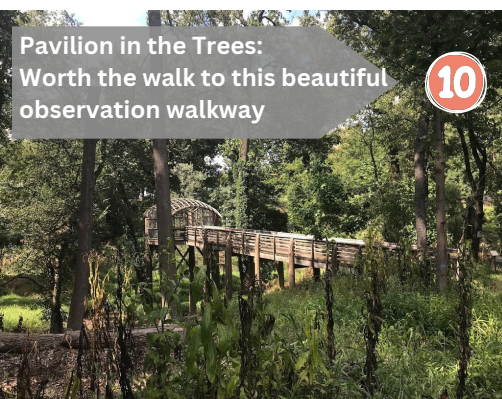
Cross the street and follow signs to access the paved footpath to the Shofuso House, home of the Cherry Blossom Festival. Pathways also lead to the Arboretum and Pavillion in the sky, great areas for picnics and wandering.

The Please Touch Museum has discount days and deals for Access pass holders. Kelly Pool is free and open during the summer.

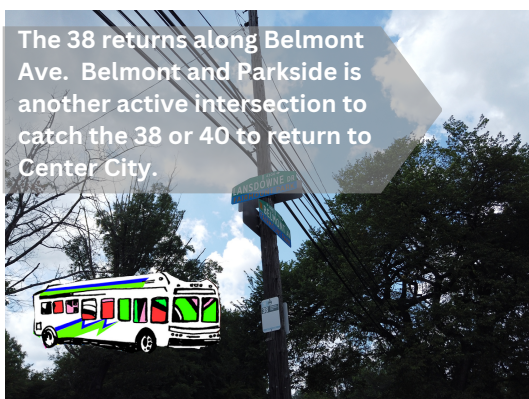
The #38 returns along Belmont. The #40 also returns to Center City from Parkside and Belmont.
